Autumn	A Season of the year
Season	A time of the year, e.g. Spring Summer,
	Autumn and Winter
Natural	Part of nature/ found outside
Leaves	Grow on branches of trees.
	They fall down in Autumn
Pine cones	An Autumn fruit, grows on pine trees
Acorn	An Autumn fruit, grows on oak trees
Rustling	Noise which leaves make
Crunchy	Noise that dry leaves make





Key Knowledge

- To know about natural, Autumn fruits such as pine cones, acorns etc.
- To recognise that leaves fall from trees in Autumn and change colour.
- To talk about some of the things I have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects (linked to Autumn).
- To begin to understand changes which I can see in Autumn.
- To recognise similarities and patterns in the natural environment.
- To understand that we can use our 5 senses to explore Autumn.
