#### **Message from Mrs Crompton**

Preparations are underway for all our Christmas festivities. Please make sure you have the 'Shadsworth Infant school Christmas Calendar Countdown 'sheet and stick it on your fridge or by the door to make sure you know the right days for party clothes, nativities and jumper days!

Children are busy practising for their Nativities. There is an Early Years (Nursery and

Reception classes) nativity and a Key Stage 1 (Yr1 and Yr2) nativity. We have allocated classes to certain days for our Nativities, this is to make sure the hall isn't overcrowded - please stick to your class day, if you have children in more than one class you can choose.

The first event is our Christmas fair next Tuesday 26th November, 3pm- 4.30pm. Please collect your child at 2.50pm from their usual doors.

We need to ask parents and families to support with our punctuality. We have opened earlier this year by 5 minutes but the effect on our 'lates' is very poor. So far this year we have had 392 late arrivals which totals 6758 minutes (112hrs) of lost learning time! 79 children have been late since September. Compared to last year where we only had 247 late (5502 lost learning minutes -92hrs). 5 minutes cannot make this difference! It is repeated children who are late every day, please get up 5-10minutes earlier so your child doesn't miss the start of the day - it's like walking into the cinema when the film has started and they are 'out of sorts' all day long. It's not a nice feeling being repeatedly late - we can sort this out easily by working together. Thank you for your support - meetings will be held for those families who are persistently late.
