Let's look at this week's story

The Football Association, an organisation that makes the rules for some football clubs, has brought out a new campaign called 'Football Without Limits'.

Think about: What do you think 'Football Without Limits' means?

Do you like football? Do you play with your family or friends, or do you go to a football club?

'Football Without Limits' means that anyone should be able to play football, including adults and children with disabilities.

Think about: What is a disability?

Discuss that some children may have disabilities, such as being blind, deaf, or having difficulty walking which might require them to use a wheelchair. For some people with disabilities, taking part in something like football may be challenging.

As part of this campaign, a football club called Comets, for children with disabilities, is happening in towns and cities across the UK. This means that children with disabilities can play football together.

Think about: Do you think everyone should be able to play football if they want to?
How do you think you would feel if you wanted to play football and were told that
you couldn't? Is the club, Comets, a good idea?







Individual Liberty

Everyone has the right to be included in sports. Through our choices and our actions, we can help to ensure everyone is included.

Protected Characteristics

Everyone should be able to participate in football. The football scheme, Comets, provides sessions for disabled children. Sport can help us celebrate the strength and skill of others, no matter who they are.
