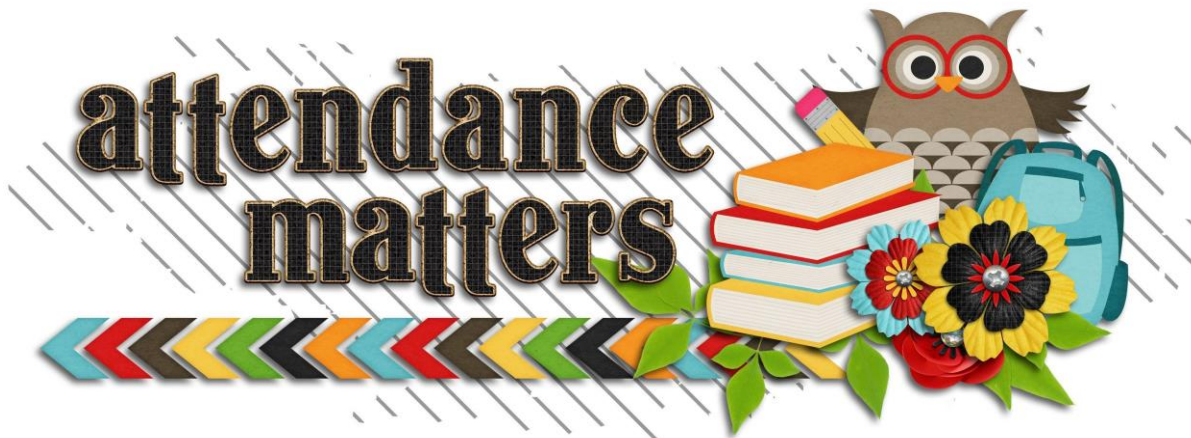

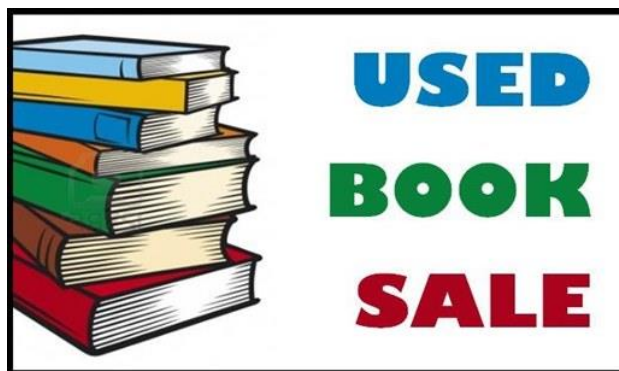
Please note that we can only accept brand-new products in original packaging with labels. This is due to the risk of infection.
