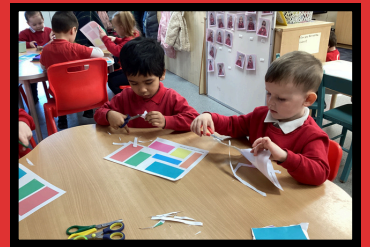


OUR LEARNING

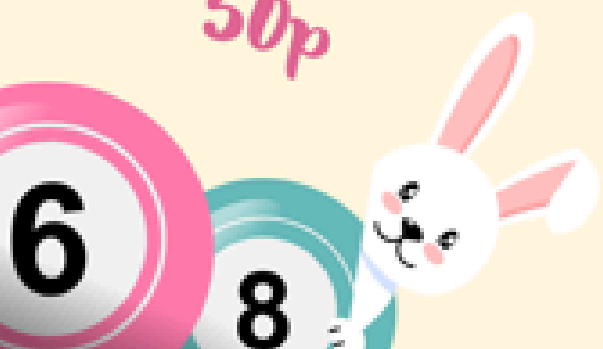
