This week we visited Smithills Farm for our school trip. We had a brilliant experience, feeding donkeys, goats, emus and rheas.

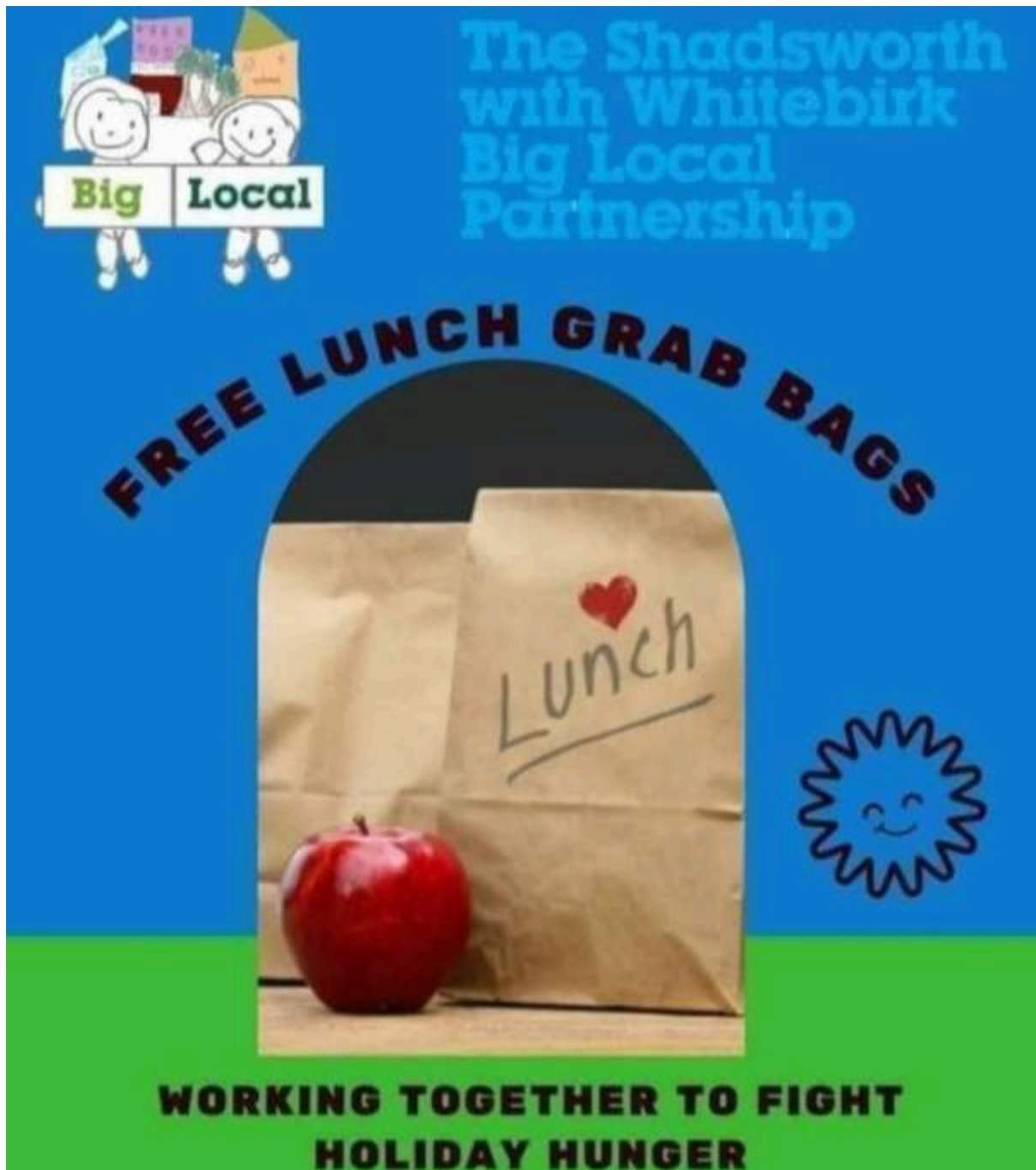
A lot of us overcame fears of big animals which is an important thing to do.
